Peter A. Dual PhD., M.P.H., founding board chair and current member of the Board of Directors, has served NCCEP for eight years. Dr. Dual served as tenured professor, academic dean and vice president for academic affairs with the California State University from 1983-2000. In the role of Dean and professor, Peter helped establish at San Diego State University the first College of Health and Human Services with the only Graduate School of Public Health in the California State University System. Peter Dual also served as Provost and Vice President for Academic Affairs at Hahnemann University Medical Center in Philadelphia and as Provost and Vice President at Eastern Washington University, Cheney Washington. Prior to University leadership experiences, Peter Dual served in K-12 school districts as a 5th grade elementary teacher, coach and community Public Health advocate. Dr. Dual's experiences in education and community have been recognized by distinguished alumnus awards from Lake Michigan College, Michigan State University College of Education, the San Diego Board of County Commissioners and the American Public Health Association.

Dr. Peter A. Dual earned an Associate of Arts Degree from Lake Michigan College, a Bachelor of Science and Masters of Arts Degree from Western Michigan University, a Doctorate of Philosophy Degree from Michigan State University and a post-doctoral, professional Masters of Public Health Degree from the University of Texas-Houston Medical Center, School Of Public Health. Peter has served on the graduate and undergraduate faculty and staff of Whitworth College, Eastern Washington University, Cal Poly State University, Pomona, Hahnemann Medical Center, San Diego State University, Eastern Michigan University, University Of Michigan-Ann Arbor, University of Texas-Austin, Michigan State University and Western Michigan University. Peter Dual has worked with universities and government in traveling extensively in Pacific Asia and Africa from 1984-1993.
