#### **INSTRUCTIONAL TECHNOLOGIES**

Companies are invited to demonstrate software and hardware that will help GEAR UP educators engage and motivate their students. These technologies will help teachers make learning more interactive, hands on, and project based so as to facilitate academic achievement.

#### **MATH/NUMERACY, SCIENCE, AND READING/LITERACY IMPROVEMENT PROGRAMS**

GEAR UP project directors will learn about products designed to help students attain desired curricular standards. These programs will help identify which skills students have mastered and which require further practice.

#### **DATA AND STUDENT MONITORING SYSTEMS**

These systems can help track the progress of students over time, including their involvement in particular GEAR UP activities, and can provide the data needed to determine which elements are the most successful and which need to be modified to maximize program effectiveness.

#### **TEST PREPARATION SERVICES**

Test preparation services will help project directors determine if partnering with such a service might benefit students and GEAR UP programs.

#### **THEATER AND ARTS-IN-EDUCATION**

Students benefit when their education is enriched with arts opportunities. Learn how the arts can help inspire students to want higher education—and prepare them to achieve it.
