This year was our first year trying this mentorship program and it has proven to be an enormous success. Students have reported that they feel more comfortable and confident with the college process in general after having peer support throughout the process.

Students also said this mentorship program has helped explore new majors and career choices that they may not have thought of without the presence of their mentor. Ashley has also gone above and beyond to help plan events, encourage attendance, and act as a mentor to students herself. Ashley has gone above and beyond to support and help this GEAR UP flourish. She is such an amazing part of this program, and we are so lucky to have her. She deserves this award and even more recognition.
