

PASSPORT GUIDE FOR TEACHERS

The College Week Passport is a guide for every student to know what the schedule for college week is, to learn CST/Star Test Taking Tips, to answer questions that get students to critically think about each event and how it helps them in their College Requirements like the A-G. Passport Cover:

*Read aloud the Promise as a class with students inserting their name in the promise.

*Each student will fill out every box in the bingo activity to complete the activity. They can ask any Everett and Beacon Staff member to answer a bingo box. One answer per box.

Calendar:

*Goes over what is happening every day, and every activity that is needed to complete Passport.

On Thursday, College Passport is turned in at lunch and will be collected by a volunteer in the yard who will give out a t-shirt.

Reminder on Thursday morning:

*Teachers please remind students to bring their shirts tomorrow to bring to the Silk screening Station at Beacon on Friday.
