Recall an instance when someone stepped in to support you during a tough educational time. Talk about that.

When did you realize that you are, in fact, a leader? Set the stage and share.

What opportunities were available to you early on to know that you would succeed?

Share a pivotal moment in your life that allowed your creative educational skills to shine.

How do you keep strong leadership skills in your current position?

What part of your personal narrative are you most proud of?

Set the stage for your best learning environment. What made that a successful place for you?

Who was the most influential in your leadership growth? What did they do to build your confidence and skills?

What superpower would you add to your list of skills? Talk about that.

What skill do you feel is your biggest asset? Talk about that.

Recall a moment when you were in the presence of your own personal champion. What happened? How did you feel?

Recall a time when an educator got you. Really took the time to help understand what you needed – asked you what would help you succeed. Share that.

Share a moment in your family history that made a positive impact on your decisions.

Share a moment in your family history that caused you to change your future direction.

Share a time in your education when someone made a positive difference in your direction.

Share a time in your education when you felt someone had your back.

Recall a time in your education when someone let you make your own learning decisions and you felt empowered by that.

Share a family story that impacted your educational decisions.

Has a student ever come back to you to tell you how you helped them succeed? Share that story.
